#5 Wedding Ring 9" Block

Select three coordinating fabrics and one background. OR combine accents for center and corners and use one dark and one accent.

From background:

- Cut (1) square 2 ½"
- Cut (4) squares 4 ½"
- Cut (1) strip 2 ¼" x 10"

From dark:

- Cut (1) square 4 ½"
- Cut (1) strip 2 ¼" x 10"

From medium accent for center ring:

- Cut (1) square 4 ½"

From medium accent for corners:

- Cut (2) squares 4 ½"

Assembly:

- Place a light and dark 4 ½" square face to face.
- Sew a ¼" seam all the way around all four sides.
- Cut the stitched square diagonally from corner to corner twice into (4) sections.
- Gently press the half squares open being careful not to stretch the bias edges.
- Trim triangles to 2 ¼" = yield 4 units
- Repeat with background and medium for center ring = yield 4 units
- Repeat with two background and two medium for corners = 8 units

Strips:

- Take 2 ¼" x 10" background and dark strips.
- Sew together with ¼" seam.
- **Subdivide with 2 ½" cuts** = yield 4 units

Block Assembly:

- Arrange one corner unit of four triangles = (2) med corner, (1) med center, (1) dark
- Sew together. Press all four seams
- Repeat for remaining three corners
- Place corners, center square and strip units into block arrangement
- Sew together and press gently

****Accuquilt:**

- Strips units, cut two 2 ½" x 10, join with ½" seam. Trim allowance or leave it.
 - Subdivide into 2 ½" sections
- Center square is 2 ½"
- Half squares need to finish 1 ¾"
