- **Fabric requirements**

- *The Halo Medallion Quilt* can be made with a wide variety of different print fabrics plus some background fabrics. A table of fabric requirements is included in the following pages; it contains a summary of the total fabric required for the quilt top. Each monthly pattern also details the fabric required to complete that month's pattern.
- While the fabrics used in this quilt are referenced throughout the pattern, you may consider adopting any other color scheme you prefer. The quilt will look great in a whole range of fabric choices such as:
  - Use a wide variety of fabrics and make your quilt totally scrappy. You could do this using reproduction-era fabrics, batiks, florals, solids, or whatever strikes your fancy!
  - Make your quilt a two-color quilt using variety of blue and yellow prints – or red and green prints – with a white-on-white background fabric.
  - For a vintage look to your quilt, use civil war reproduction fabrics, combined with shirting prints as background fabric.
  - Use a monochromatic color scheme in your quilt: make it using all blue or all neutral fabrics, ranging from pale to dark prints with a white-on-white background fabric.
- You do not necessarily have to select all of your fabrics before you begin. While you may choose your fabrics before you start, as you make the quilt, you may find that you want to add or subtract various fabrics, depending on what looks best.

- **Tools.** You will not need any special tools in order to make this quilt, other than a few basic sewing supplies. Below is a list of items that you might want to gather together before getting started:




- **Paper Foundations.** Typing paper, *Quilters Select Print and Piece*, *Thangles* or *Triangle Paper* (Laundry Basket Quilts) will aid in your precision piecing.
- **Three-ring binder and page dividers.**
- **Printer paper and ink cartridges**




**Tip:** After you have printed out each month's set of instructions, place them in a 3-hole notebook. This will keep all of your patterns together and allow you to quickly refer to an earlier lesson if you need to. You can also keep the complete list of fabric (found in the Introduction) readily available for future use.

**Tip:** Read through each month's instructions before starting. You may read something that will save you a step or two, or make your task easier.

**Tip:** Cut all of the fabric you will be using each month, before you start sewing; it streamlines the assembly of the block and border units.

**Tip:** Tape a swatch of each of the fabrics you use on the table below, so that you can easily reference the fabrics you have used in each portion of this quilt.
