

Modern Log Cabin – Small Block

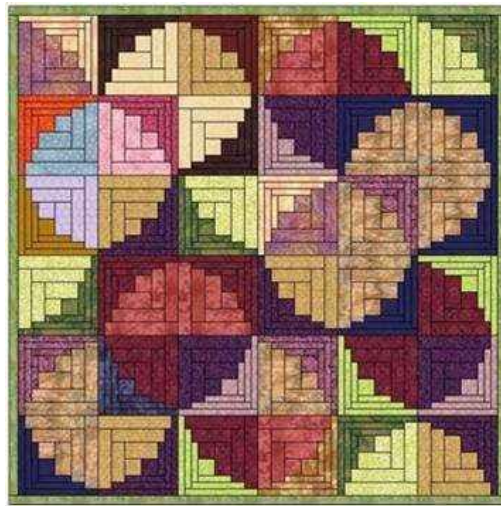
5 ½" blocks 36 blocks

Total 33" square plus 1 ½" border = 36"

Yardage - one 5 ½" finished block:

- The wide strip requires 22" x 1.5"
- The narrow side requires a square 1.5" x 1.5" and one narrow strip is 24" x 1"
- Some color pairs have one log cabin block. One pair has 4 repeats. The balance of the 36 blocks will have 2 or 3 repeats.

That means: the very MOST you will of one color/fabric is 5" x WOF to complete 4 repeats of a block. The project can be done easily with 30 fabrics and not have to repeat any pairs except where designated. My preference for more allows me to take a required 4 block set and swap out a fabric for another very similar value/fabric with a close color.



Color/Value A – narrow strips:

- 1.5 x 1.5
- 1 x 2.5
- 1 x 3
- 1 x 4
- 1 x 4.5
- 1 x 5.5
- 1 x 6

Color/Value B – wide strips:

- 1.5 x 1.5
- 1.5 x 2.5
- 1.5 x 3
- 1.5 x 4
- 1.5 x 4.5
- 1.5 x 5.5

Color/Value B – narrow strips:

- 1.5 x 1.5
- 1 x 2.5
- 1 x 3
- 1 x 4
- 1 x 4.5
- 1 x 5.5
- 1 x 6

Color/Value A – wide strips:

- 1.5 x 1.5
- 1.5 x 2.5
- 1.5 x 3
- 1.5 x 4
- 1.5 x 4.5
- 1.5 x 5.5
